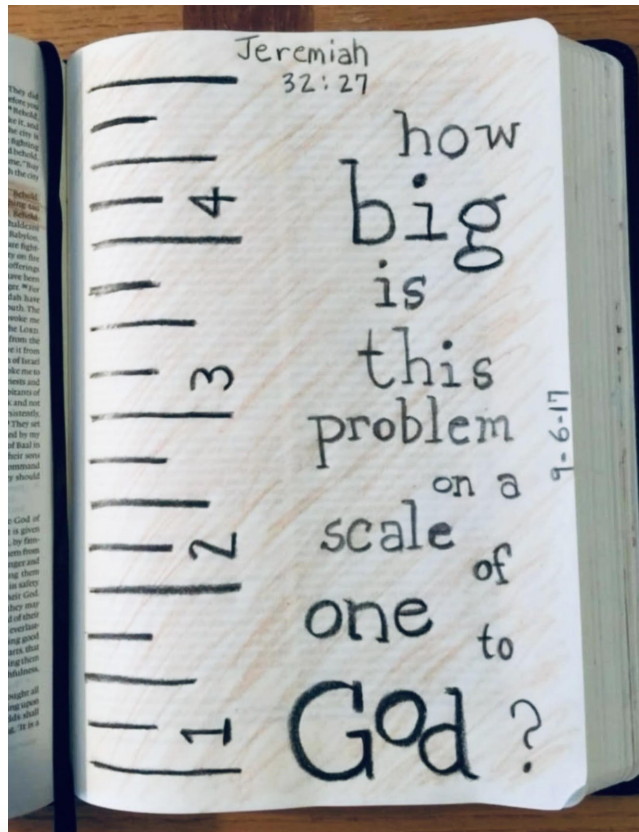

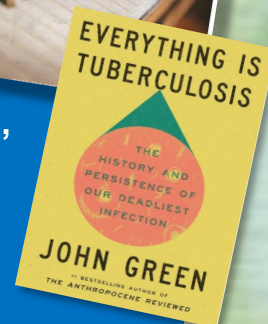
COMFORTING WORDS Christian Women's Book Club
